# JUVENILE PROBATION SERVICES

## Standard Conditions of Family Probation

- You shall obey all laws-federal, state and municipal
- You shall not have in your possession any firearm or other dangerous weapon.
- You shall report to your probation officer as directed.
- You shall not leave New Jersey without the permission of your probation officer.
- You shall not leave your home/residence for more than 24 hours without permission of your probation officer.
- You shall permit your probation officer to visit your residence and to see and talk with you at any suitable place.
- You shall notify your probation officer immediately of any change in residence, school, employment and contact with law enforcement agencies.
- You shall answer promptly, truthfully, and completely all inquiries made by your probation officer.

## Standard Conditions of Family Probation

- You shall participate in any detection, diagnostic, or therapeutic program as determined by the court and/or your probation officer.
- You shall attend school or be employed.
- You shall pay, through the probation division, any and all monies ordered to be paid by the court in strict accord with terms fixed by the court. Failure to comply could result in further court action, including filing a civil judgment and/or extension of your probation term.
- You shall abide by curfew imposed by your probation officer or the court.
- You shall comply with any additional special conditions of probation specifically imposed by the court
