11284) and (2) the updated kit on "How to Apply for Foreclosure Mediation" (CN 11270).

This notice supersedes all previous notices regarding foreclosure mediation.

The basis for this new notice requirement is the renewed availability of certified

housing counselors, provided through the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance

Agency, to assist homeowners involved in foreclosure mediation. The housing

counselors will be available to assist homeowners in gathering documentation

necessary to the mediation and in evaluating and responding to document requests

relating to the mediation.
