5. No discovery, motion, trial or any other proceeding delay shall occur or be requested by reason of the inability of Mr. Alexander to be in attendance.
6. Mr. Alexander must, within ten (10) days, pay the fees required by *R. 1:20-1(b)* and *R. 1:28-2*.
7. Pro hac vice admission will automatically terminate for failure to make the initial and any annual payment required by *R. 1:20-1(b)* and *R. 1:28-2*.

8. Non-compliance with any of the terms of this Order shall constitute grounds for removal.
