IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Treasurer of the New Jersey Fund for Client Protection; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that copies of this Order shall be served by attorneys for Plaintiff on the attached Schedule "A", upon counsel for the defendants within seven (7) days of the receipt thereof.
