4. have all pleadings and other papers filed in this Court signed by an attorney-at-law of this Court employed by the firm of PORZIO, BROMBERG & NEWMAN, P.C., who shall be responsible for the conduct of Jennifer Snyder Heis, and it is further

**ORDERED** that Jennifer Snyder Heis shall make payment of fees as provided in the New Jersey Rules of Court, R. 1:28-1(b), 1:28-2, and 1:28b-1(e); and it is further
