**ORDER**

IT IS ON THIS 18<sup>th</sup> day of June 2014

ORDERED that where a representative of a defendant is noticed for a deposition and is unable or unavailable to appear on the designated date, a new date must be supplied for that deposition to take place within 45 days of the original deposition date. Any further extension shall be upon application to the Special Master for good cause shown.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that where the notice of deposition calls for the production of documents, such documents must be produced 10 days in advance of the scheduled deposition date.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT in the event the defendant objects or refuses to produce the representative for a deposition, defendant shall file a motion for protective order in accordance with the New Jersey Court Rules.
