CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER

THIS MATTER having come before the Court by consent of counsel for Plaintiffs and counsel for Defendant and for good cause shown,

IT IS on this day of April, 2010, ORDERED as follows:

- Plaintiff is permitted to take the depositions of two Merck professional
 representatives in the matter of Harriett Singer v. Merck. These depositions must be
 completed by April 15, 2010 and Plaintiff must accept the dates on which these
 representatives are offered for deposition provided 7 days advance notice is provided.
 If Plaintiff counsel is not available on those dates, the deposition shall not proceed.
- 2. Counsel for Plaintiff Alison Rosenberg shall speak to Mrs. Rosenberg regarding the fact that her Israeli medical records need to be provided directly to defense counsel by Mrs. Rosenberg's Israeli providers.
