IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that

1. Mr. Palmer shall abide by the New Jersey Rules of Court, including all

disciplinary rules;

2. Mr. Palmer shall consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the New Jersey Supreme Court as an agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against him or his firm that may arise out of his participation in this matter;


4. Mr. Palmer shall notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting his standing at the bar of any other court;

5. Mr. Palmer shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with this Court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in the State of New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for such papers, for the conduct of this cause and for Mr. Palmer; and

6. Mr. Palmer shall comply with New Jersey Court Rules 1:20-1(b) and 1:28-2(a) by paying the fees required by those Rules; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Treasurer of the New Jersey Fund for Client Protection; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order shall be served upon all relevant parties within seven days of counsel's receipt of same.
