

4. Mr. Sanders shall notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting his standing at the bar of any other court;
5. Mr. Sanders shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with this Court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in the State of New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for such papers, for the conduct of this cause and for Mr. Sanders; and
6. Mr. Sanders shall comply with New Jersey Court Rules 1:20-1(b) and 1:28-2(a) by paying the fees required by those Rules; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Treasurer of the New Jersey Fund for Client Protection; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order shall be served upon all relevant parties within seven days of counsel's receipt of same.
