THIS MATTER HAVING COME before the Court on application of Christopher M. Placitella, Esquire, attorney for the Plaintiffs and the Court having reviewed the papers filed herein, and for good cause shown, namely that the matter involves a complex area of law and that Jonathan D. Orent, Esquire is a specialist,

IT IS on this 14 day of May, 2010,

ORDERED as follows,

THAT Jonathan D. Orent, Esquire be hereby admitted Pro Hac Vice in the above captioned matter, pursuant to R.1:21-2; and

THAT Jonathan D. Orent, Esquire shall abide by the New Jersey Court Rules including all disciplinary rules; and

THAT Jonathan D. Orent, Esquire shall consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as an agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against his firm that may arise out of his participation in this matter; and

THAT Jonathan D. Orent, Esquire shall notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting his standing at the bar of any other Court; and

THAT Jonathan D. Orent, Esquire shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court signed by Christopher M. Placitella, Esquire, or another attorney of record who is authorized to practice in this State, and who shall be held responsible for them and the conduct of the cause and of attorney Jonathan D. Orent, Esquire; and

THAT Jonathan D. Orent, Esquire shall within ten (10) days of the date of this Order comply with R.1:20-1(b), R. 1:28B-1(e) and R.1:28-2 by paying the appropriate fees to the Oversight Committee, to the Lawyer's Assistance Fund and the New Jersey Lawyer's Fund for Client Protection no later than February 1st of each year thereafter and shall submit an affidavit of compliance; and

THAT Jonathan D. Orent, Esquire shall not be designated as trial counsel; and

THAT no adjournment or delay in discovery, motions, trial or any other proceeding will be requested by reason of Jonathan D. Orent, Esquire's inability to appear; and

THAT automatic termination of Pro Hac Vice admission of Jonathan D. Orent, Esquire shall occur for failure to make the required annual payment of the Annual Fee and the annual payment to the Lawyer's Assistance Fund and the New Jersey Lawyer's Fund for Client Protection. Proof of such payment, after filing proof of the initial payment, shall be made no later than February of each year; and

THAT noncompliance with any of these requirements shall constitute grounds for removal; and

THAT a copy of this Order shall be served on all parties within seven (7) days of the date of this Order.
