ORDERED that the motion is granted, and that Christin DiMartino, Esq. is admitted to practice *pro hac vice* before this Court in this matter pursuant to R. 1:21-2, for all purposes and in the same manner as an attorney who is admitted to practice in this State and is domiciled and maintains an office for the practice of law in the State of New Jersey, provided that she shall:

1) abide by the Rules of Courts for the State of New Jersey as adopted by the Supreme Court, including all disciplinary rules;

2) consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against his or her firm that may arise out of participation in this matter;

3) notify this Court immediately of any matter affecting her standing at the bar of any other court; and

4) have all pleadings, motions, correspondence, briefs and other papers submitted to the Court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in the State of New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for them, and for the conduct of the cause, and of Christin DiMartino.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Christin DiMartino shall comply annually with the New Jersey Rules of Court, R. 1:20-1(b), 1:28-2 and 1:28B-1(e), and pay the annual required payment to the Ethics Financial Committee and the New Jersey Fund for Client Protection. If she has not done so for this year already, she will make payment within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Treasurer of the New Jersey Fund for Client Protection; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that counsel for plaintiffs shall serve a copy of this Order upon all counsel of record within seven (7) days of the receipt thereof.
