ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S NOTICE OF MOTION FOR ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE OF STEVEN JAMES BORANIAN, ESQ.

IT IS on this 26 day of January, 2018,

ORDERED that Bard's Motion for the Admission of Steven James Boranian, Esq., *pro hac vice* is hereby **GRANTED**; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Steven James Boranian, Esq. shall:

1. Abide by the New Jersey Court Rules, including all disciplinary rules;

2. Consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as the agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against his firm that may arise out of his participation in this matter;

3. Notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting his standing at the Bar of any other court;


4. Have all pleadings, briefs, and other papers filed with the Court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in this State, who shall be held responsible for them, the conduct of the case, and the attorney admitted herein;

FURTHER ORDERED that the admission of Steven James Boranian, Esq. is subject to any conditions imposed by the judge hearing the trial of this matter; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the admission of Steven James Boranian, Esq. shall not in any way delay the trial of this matter, nor serve as a basis for any application for adjournment of trial of this matter; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Steven James Boranian, Esq. will make all required payments to the New Jersey Fund for Client Protection within 30 days hereof and shall annually comply with R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2(a) during the period of her admission; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order shall be served upon all counsel within seven (7) days of the date of this Order.
