**ORDER GRANTING THE MOTION  
FOR THE *PRO HAC VICE* ADMISSION  
OF LEE B. BALESKY IN CASES ON  
ATTACHED SCHEDULE A**

THIS MATTER having come before the Court on Motion by Plaintiffs for an Order admitting Lee B. Balesky, Esquire, an attorney admitted to the practice of law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to participate *pro hac vice* in the above-captioned action; and the Court having read and considered all submissions in connection with the Motion; and good cause appearing;

IT IS on this 15 day of March, 2018,

ORDERED that Lee B. Balesky, Esquire is hereby admitted *pro hac vice* to represent Plaintiffs in cases on attached Schedule A; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. Mr. Balefsky, Esquire shall abide by the New Jersey Rules of Court, including all disciplinary rules, R. 1:20-1 and R. 1:28-2;
2. Mr. Balefsky shall and hereby does consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as his agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against him that may rise out of his individual participation in this matter;
3. Mr. Balefsky shall immediately notify the Court of any matter affecting his standing at the Bar of any other Court;
4. Mr. Balefsky shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in the State of New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for them, the conduct of the litigation and the attorney admitted herein;
5. Mr. Balefsky cannot be designated as trial counsel;
6. No delay in discovery, motions, trial or any other proceeding shall occur or be requested by reason of the inability of Mr. Balefsky to be in attendance;
7. Mr. Balefsky must, within ten (10) days of the entry of this Order, pay the fees required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2 and submit an affidavit of compliance;
8. *Pro Hac Vice* admission will automatically terminate for failure to make the initial and required annual payment required by Rule 1:20-1(b) and Rule 1:28-2;
9. Non-compliance with any of the terms of this Order shall constitute grounds for removal; and
10. A copy of this order shall be served on all parties within seven (7) days of the date of this order.
