3. Notify the court of any matter affecting his standing at the bar of any other jurisdiction; and


4. Have all pleadings, briefs, and other papers filed with the court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in the State of New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for them and for the conduct of the litigation and of the attorney admitted herein; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Christopher S. McRae, Esq. must pay the fees required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2;
