**ORDER GRANTING THE MOTION FOR

THIS MATTER having come before the Court on Motion by Plaintiff Jacquelyn Warner for an Order admitting Wendy R. Fleishman, Esquire, an attorney admitted to the practice of law in the State of California, to participate *pro hac vice* in the above-captioned action; and the Court having read and considered all submissions in connection with the Motion; and good cause shown;

IT IS, on this 13 day of May, 2016,

ORDERED that Wendy R. Fleishman, Esquire is admitted to practice *pro hac vice* before this court pursuant to R. 1:21-2, for all purposes and in all proceedings in connection with the above-captioned action, in the same manner as an attorney who is admitted to practice in this State and is domiciled and maintains an office for the practice of law in the State of New Jersey, provided that:

1. Ms. Fleishman shall abide by the Rules of the Court for the State of New Jersey and all disciplinary rules;
2. Ms. Fleishman shall and hereby does consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as her agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against her or her respective firm that may arise out of his participation in the matter;
3. Ms. Fleishman shall notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting her standing at the bar of any Court; and
4. Ms. Fleishman shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed in this Court signed by an attorney authorized to practice in this State who shall be responsible for them and for the conduct of the cause of Wendy R. Fleishman, Esquire therein.
5. Wendy R. Fleishman, Esquire shall make payment of fees as provided in the New Jersey Rules of the Court, R. 1:20-1(b), 1:28-2 and 1:28B-1(e).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT

That the Clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Treasurer of the New Jersey Fund for Client Protection; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT a copy of this Order shall be served on all parties within seven (7) days of the date hereof.
