ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

THIS MATTER having been opened to the Court by Defendants, Ethicon, Inc. and Johnson & Johnson (collectively "Defendants"); and the Court having reviewed the Certification of Kelly S. Crawford in Support of Entry of Order to Show Cause (the "Certification"); and for good cause shown:

IT IS on this 13 day of June, 2016:

ORDERED that Joel L. Tabas, Chapter 7 Trustee of the Bankruptcy Estate of Robert and Gisselle Velazquez (the "Chapter 7 Trustee"), appear and show cause on the 20th day of

July, 2016, before the Honorable Brian R. Martinotti, J.S.C., of the Superior Court of New Jersey, Law Division, at the Bergen County Justice Center, 10 Main Street, Hackensack, NJ 07601, at 10:30 AM a.m./p.m., or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard, why an order should not be entered dismissing this action due the Chapter 7 Trustee's failure to prosecute and timely file an amended complaint; and

IT IS FURTHER **ORDERED** that a copy of this Order to Show Cause and the Certification shall be served by Defendants' counsel upon the Chapter 7 Trustee, by and through his counsel, Wagstaff & Cartmell, LLP, 4740 Grand Avenue, Kansas City, MO 64112 and Law Offices of Sadaka Associates LLC, Attn: Mark T. Sadaka, Esq., 155 North Dean Street, 4th Floor, Englewood, NJ 97631, by regular mail, within 7 days from the date of this Order to Show Cause; and

IT IS FURTHER **ORDERED** that the Chapter 7 Trustee shall file and serve any response to this Order to Show Cause no later than 1 July, 2016.

IT IS FURTHER **ORDERED** that if the Chapter 7 Trustee does not file and serve opposition to this order to show cause, the application will be decided on the papers on the return date and relief may be granted by default, provided that the Defendants file a proof of service and a proposed form of order at least three days prior to the return date.
