ORDER


THIS MATTER having been brought before the Court by Defendants Ethicon, Inc. and Johnson & Johnson (“Defendants”), through their counsel Riker Danzig Scherer Hyland & Perretti, LLP, at the Case Management Conference conducted on June 25, 2018; counsel appearing; pursuant to the Case Management Order #44 section III.A.2.b(ii), for good cause shown,

IT IS on this 29th day of June, 2018, ORDERED that:

I. Within 10 calendar days of the date of this Order, Plaintiff shall execute Proprietary Authorizations for the collection of records from the (1) Bellevue Hospital Center; (2) New York State Psychiatric Institute; and (3) any facility or provider identified pursuant to certain medical records discussed with the Court at the June 25, 2018 Case Management

Conference. Records shall be collected pursuant to the protocol established by the Case Management Order #3 dated April 25, 2012, which provides for records collection for the time period starting twenty (20) years prior to the date of Plaintiff's initial mesh implant surgery (here, March 28, 1988) through the present date, and may be supplemented through the time of trial.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order shall be served upon all counsel within seven (7) days of the date of this Order.
