This matter having been opened to The Court by defendants; it appearing that on August 27, 2020 The Court (per the undersigned) entered a Case Management Order No. 8 (Plaintiff Profile Forms); and good cause appearing,

IT IS on this 14th day of January, 2021,

ORDERED that:

1. Defendants are hereby granted leave to file motions to dismiss the Complaints of any plaintiff who does not submit a fully executed, responsive Plaintiff Profile Form with the required duly executed authorizations in accordance with the Case Management Order No. 8 (Plaintiff Profile Forms) provided that the requirements of section (m) of CMO No. 8 (re: notice of delinquency) have been fulfilled; and

2. If the Court grants defendants' motion to dismiss, it will be without prejudice. The plaintiff or plaintiff's representative will have 60 days from the date of the order granting the dismissal to file a motion to vacate the dismissal and reinstate the Complaint. The motion to vacate and reinstate the Complaint must include a fully responsive Plaintiff Profile Form and the required fully executed authorizations.
