CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 33


THIS MATTER having been brought before the Court at a case management conference on September 25, 2018, and counsel for plaintiffs and counsel for defendants having been present, and for good cause shown,

IT IS on this th 30 day of October, 2018, **ORDERED THAT:**

1. Minor plaintiffs Devon Mowell (Hill) (L-10263-14) and Blake W. Spoon (L-10056-14), and their appointed guardians or other representatives, and their counsel shall appear in person or by video for a *Friendly* hearing to approve settlement on or before November 8, 2018. If a plaintiff, or his/her appointed guardian or other representative, or his/her counsel fail to appear for a *Friendly* hearing by that date, defense counsel shall be permitted to file a motion to terminate the case.
2. Minor plaintiff Caden Barrett (L-10714-14), and his appointed guardians or other representatives, and his counsel shall appear in person or by video for a *Friendly* hearing to approve settlement on or before November 8, 2018. If the plaintiff, or his appointed guardian or other representative, or his counsel fail to appear for a *Friendly* hearing by that date, defense counsel shall be permitted to file a motion to terminate the case.

3. Ralph Pittle, Esq. and Ryan Kilmer, Esq., counsel for Plaintiffs Benton (MID-L-10173-14) and Goodson (MID-L-10337-14), shall provide new medical authorizations from the Plaintiffs to the remaining Defendants within five (5) days of the date hereof.
4. Plaintiffs' and Defendants' Liaison Counsel are no longer necessary to coordinate this litigation. Accordingly, Plaintiffs' and Defendants' Liaison Counsel and their law firms, as designated in Case Management Order No. 2, are hereby relieved of their official liaison roles and duties.
5. Counsel for Plaintiffs and Defendants that are no longer parties to an active case are not required to attend future case management conferences absent a contrary direction by the Court.
6. The next case management conference is scheduled for November 8, 2018 at 11 a.m.
