**ORDERED THAT:**

1. Counsel for Plaintiff will provide the Court with all past correspondence between Plaintiff's Counsel and Garretson Resolution Group ("Garretson") about Garretson's administration of the resolution of the Medicare lien in *Samantha Spoon, as parent and natural guardian of Blake Spoon. v. Wyeth, et al.*, MID-L-010056-14 by August 13, 2019; and


2. Counsel for Plaintiff will also provide the Court with correspondence from the Plaintiff's Counsel to Garretson regarding expediting the resolution of the Medicare lien in *Samantha Spoon, as parent and natural guardian of Blake Spoon. v. Wyeth, et al.*, MID-L-010056-14 by August 13, 2019; and

3. If Counsel for Plaintiff, Ted Oshman, Esq., fails to abide Nos. 1 and 2 of this Order, this Court shall *sua sponte* enter an Order to Show Cause against Plaintiff's Counsel, and he shall appear and show cause on a date and time certain as to why he should not be adjudged to be in contempt of the court and face imprisonment and/or fines for failure to comply with a directive of this Court; and

4. Counsel for PLIVA, Inc. and for Plaintiffs Benton (MID-L-10173-14) and Goodson (MID-L-10337-14) shall complete fact discovery and submit case scheduling orders by February 3, 2020; and

5. The next case management conference is scheduled for August 13, 2019 at 10 a.m.
