process may be made for all actions that may hereinafter be brought against him or his firm arising from their participation in this matter; and it is further

ORDERED that Andrew Myers, Esq. shall notify this Court immediately if any matter arises that affects his standing before the Bar of the State of Colorado; and it is further

ORDERED that all pleadings, brief and other papers filed on behalf of NorthStar Rx LLC, shall also be signed by a member of the firm of Hardin, Kundla, McKeon & Poletto, and that firm shall be responsible for such papers and the conduct of this case and of Andrew Myers, Esq.; and it is further

ORDERED that Andrew Myers, Esq. shall pay the annual fees prescribed by New Jersey Court Rules 1:20-1 and 1:28-2 within twenty (20) days from the date of the entry of this Order; and it is further,

ORDERED that a signed copy of this Order shall be served upon all counsel within seven (7) days of the date hereof.
