4. Louis M. Bograd, Esq., shall allow all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court signed by an attorney of records authorized to practice in the State, who shall be held responsible for him, the conduct of the cause and the admitted attorney herein;

5. Louis M. Bograd, Esq., must within fifteen (15) days pay any and all fees required by the New Jersey Supreme Court pursuant to R.1:20-1(b), the New Jersey Lawyers' Fund for Client protection pursuant to R.1:28-2; and the Annual Assessment to the Lawyer's Assistance Program R.1:28B-1(e) and submit Affidavits of Compliance;

6. Louis M. Bograd, Esq., shall send a copy of this Order with the annual fee to the New Jersey Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection.
