ORDER

THIS MATTER having originally been brought before the Court by Drinker Biddle & Reath LLP, attorneys for Defendants Ortho-McNeil-Janssen Pharmaceuticals, Inc. (f/k/a Janssen Pharmaceutica, Inc. (erroneously designated as “Janssen Pharmaceutica Products, L.P., a/k/a Janssen, L.P., a/k/a Janssen Pharmaceutica, L.P., a/k/a Janssen Pharmaceutica, Inc.”) and Johnson and Johnson to dismiss Plaintiff’s Complaint based on the doctrine of *forum non conveniens*; and then in response, a brief submitted by Bailey Perrin Bailey, attorneys for Plaintiff Diane Houston, on behalf of Russell Houston, in opposition to Defendants’ Motion; and then in response to the Court having considered the papers submitted on behalf of the Plaintiffs and Defendants, Plaintiff submitted a Motion to Reconsider Dismissal of Plaintiff’s Complaint

Based on Doctrine of *Forum Non Conveniens*; and the Court having heard the arguments of counsel, if any; and for good cause shows:

IT IS ON THIS 20 day of June, 2008;

ORDERED that the Plaintiff's Motion to Reconsider is **GRANTED** and it is **ORDERED** that the Order of May 2, 2008 dismissing plaintiff's Complaint without prejudice be and hereby is VACATED, and the Complaint in the above-captioned action be and hereby is reinstated; and it is further

ORDERED that counsel for plaintiffs shall serve a copy of this Order on counsel for defendant within 7 days of the date of this Order.
