[PROPOSED] CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 2

THIS MATTER having come before the Court for a Case Management Conference on January 23, 2019, and the parties having met and conferred; and for good cause shown:


IT IS on this 5 day of February, 2019,

ORDERED as follows:

1. The Parties shall meet and confer as to the scope of the protective order within the next ten days. If a resolution cannot be reached, the Parties shall submit a single redline and corresponding submissions setting forth their positions on the paragraphs in dispute by February 6, 2019.
2. The Parties shall meet and confer to discuss the entry of an agreed upon Plaintiff Fact Sheet and ESI Order within the next two weeks. If a resolution cannot be reached, the Parties shall submit a single redline and corresponding submissions setting forth their positions on the paragraphs in dispute by February 13, 2019.
3. Any and all documents provided to defense counsel in response to the Product Identification Order shall be considered confidential information pursuant to the

proposed Protective Order and treated as such in accordance with the New Jersey law as well as any Orders of this Court. At the next Case Management Conference, the Court will discuss Plaintiffs' counsels' position that deadlines should be established for Defendants to dispute the documentary evidence produced by Plaintiffs pursuant to the Product Identification Order.

4. Prior to the next Case Management Conference, the Parties shall meet and confer to discuss a proposal for Science Day.
5. The next Case Management Conference is scheduled for February 27, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. before the Undersigned in Courtroom 403 at the Middlesex County Courthouse, 56 Patterson Street, New Brunswick, New Jersey. The Parties shall submit a joint agenda to the Court listing the issues for the case management conference, via e-mail, by 12:00 PM on February 20, 2019. Liaison Counsel for the parties shall circulate a dial-in to all counsel of record and the Court prior to the conference.
6. The official record shall be the transcript provided by the Court reporter retained by counsel. The reporter shall preserve all proceedings and shall email a transcript of any Court proceeding to the court within fourteen (14) days of the proceeding.
