**THIS MATTER** having being brought on the court's own motion, and for good cause shown;

IT IS ON THIS 19 day of May, 2006, ORDERED as follows:

1. From this point forward any attorney which is to be admitted *pro hac vice* in the New Jersey ACCUTANE® litigation must file a motion in compliance with the New Jersey Court Rules which specifically lists the docket number of the cases for which the attorney wishes to be admitted. There will be a \$30.00 fee required for each docket number.
2. As new cases are filed, the attorney must file a new motion to be added as *pro hac vice* on any new case(s) paying a \$30.00 fee for any such motions. The motions can be filed separately or as one motion with a list of the individual docket numbers attached.
3. A second motion for admission in the ACCUTANE® litigation for additional cases will not require that all the papers that were attached to the original motion be attached, but will require a certification that he/she has previously been admitted and remains in good standing and has paid all fees required by the New Jersey Rules.
