THIS MATTER having been opened on the Court's own motion in furtherance of the Order signed by Chief Justice Deborah Poritz for the Supreme Court of the State of New Jersey designating this Court to centralize all pending cases alleging injuries and/or claims from the ingestion of PPA; and

WHEREAS the following standardized forms will be used for all pro hac vice admissions for discovery purposes only:

IT IS ON THIS 9<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2003, ORDERED that Case Management Order No. 3 A is amended to include:

**Pro Hac Vice Admissions Certification**

1. Any attorney seeking admission pro hac vice shall make a formal motion for admission returnable before Judge Corodemus on a scheduled motion day. The

motion must be made on the applicant's behalf by a fully licensed member of the New Jersey Bar, using the form of motion annexed hereto. Motions for the admission of counsel pro hac vice shall be decided on the papers submitted unless opposition to the motion is filed or the court otherwise directs oral argument by presented. The admission, if granted, shall be deemed to apply to all cases pending in or in part of Mass Tort Case No. 264 **No more than eight (8) counsel shall be admitted pro hac vice on behalf of any party during the same period during the discovery process. Once the discovery process is completed, no more than four (4) counsel shall be admitted pro hac vice on behalf of any party during the same period. There will be no adjournments due to the inability of pro hac vice counsel to be in attendance.**
