And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **C. WILLIAM BOWKLEY, JR.**, Judge of the Municipal Court, is hereby admonished for violating Canons 1, 2A, and 3C(1) of the Code of Judicial Conduct, and Rule 2:15-8(a)(6).
