SUBJECT: **Revised Statewide Violations Bureau Schedule**

DATE: April 22, 2002

At its March 12, 2002 Administrative Conference, the Supreme Court amended the Statewide Violations Bureau Schedule (Statewide Schedule). **Those amendments are effective May 1, 2002.** The amendments were prompted by recommendations of the Municipal Court Practice Committee. A copy of the revised Statewide Schedule is attached and will be published in the New Jersey Law Journal and New Jersey Lawyer.

The principal changes to the Statewide Schedule include increased toll amounts and E-Z Pass violation fines on the New Jersey Turnpike, a number of new violations to existing sections of the Statewide Schedule requested by the Division of Fish and Wildlife, the addition of a new section regarding deer hunting violations, and a number of changes by the Division of Fish and Wildlife due to Federal regulatory changes. **Please note that none of the changes to the Statewide Schedule affect the design of or offenses listed on either the Uniform Traffic Ticket or Special Form of Complaint and Summons.**
