The municipal courts are under the direct supervision of the Assignment Judge and the Trial Court Administrator. The Presiding Judge and the Municipal Division Manager form an executive component as established throughout the Judiciary. This executive component is given the responsibility of the daily administration of the municipal courts with the Presiding Judge having overall responsibility and the Municipal Division Manager having immediate responsibility.

The Municipal Division reviews court operations to ensure compliance with state legislation, court rules, and directives as they relate to the municipal courts. The review process includes annual visits to the 52 municipal courts within the Monmouth Vicinage which encompasses 665 square miles.

The municipal courts receive ongoing assistance in the areas of case management, facility planning, budget preparation, financial management, and training. In addition to acting as liaison for the municipal courts, the Municipal

Division develops and implements vicinage wide policies, procedures, and programs for the municipal courts.

Complementary Dispute Resolution (CDR) Volunteer Mediation Program

This program provides for volunteers to act as impartial moderators and to conduct informal sessions with disputing parties to resolve non-violent minor disputes and petty offenses such as noise complaints, pet complaints and property disputes outside of the traditional route of litigation.
