Minority Concerns Committee Sponsors Expungement Seminars

CAMDEN, NJ - The Camden County Superior Court's Advisory Committee on Minority Concerns will sponsor three expungement seminars in the month of June. The seminars will be conducted by Acting Assistant Prosecutor Cheryl Cohen, Esq.

Cohen will share information with the community on topics such as who is eligible for expungement; which types of convictions can and cannot be expunged; how an expungement is filed; and what happens at the expungement hearing. Community members will also have the opportunity to ask Cohen questions about the expungement process.

With the guidance of the New Jersey Supreme Court Committee on Minority Concerns, the Camden Vicinage Minority Concerns Committee is tasked with assuring fairness, impartiality, equal access, and full participation of ethnic and racial minorities in the Judiciary. These seminars are but one example of the programs and initiatives the Committee has offered in the effort to increase the community's understanding of and access to the judicial system.

The first seminar will take place at the Camden County Store at Echelon Mall (1285 Echelon Mall Drive, 2nd Floor, Voorhees, NJ) on Thursday, June 8, 2006 from 1 to 3 p.m.. The second will be held on Wednesday, June 14, 2006 from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. at the Camden County Service Center at South County Regional Library (35 Coopers Folly Road,

Winslow, NJ). The final seminar will be held on Monday, June 19, 2006 from 5 to 7 p.m. in at the Camden County College Technology Center, Camden City Campus (600 Cooper Street, Classroom 203, Camden, NJ).

The seminars are free of charge and are open to all Camden County residents.
