Honorable G. Dolph Corradino Appointed as Municipal Court Presiding Judge

New Jersey Chief Justice Deborah T. Poritz has appointed the Honorable G. Dolph Corradino to the position of presiding judge for the Passaic County Municipal Courts. The appointment was effective July 1, 2006.

As presiding judge, Judge Corradino will be responsible for working with the judges from each of Passaic's 16 municipal courts to ensure their smooth operation, to maintain continuity among the courts, to address any questions or problems that may arise among the judges, and to implement all administrative rules, policies and directives of the Supreme Court, the chief justice, the administrative director and the assignment judge.

"Judge Corradino is an excellent judge. I am confident that he will do a fine job leading our municipal courts," stated Assignment Judge Robert J. Passero.

Judge Corradino replaces Judge Murner, who is stepping down effective June 30, 2006 after serving as presiding judge since 1999. Judge Murner will continue to serve on the bench in Wayne Municipal Court.

Judge Corradino holds two bachelor degrees from Seton Hall University and a law degree from Seton Hall Law School. He began practicing law in 1966 and has had an extensive career in private practice. Judge Corradino's current law practice is in Little Falls, where he currently resides. In addition, he has presided over the Little Falls Municipal Court for the past 13 years.

"I am honored to be appointed to the position of presiding judge, and I can ensure that the trust placed in me will not be in vain," stated Judge Corradino.
