Camden Vicinage Minority Concerns Committee Sponsors Expungement Seminars

CAMDEN, NJ - The Camden County Superior Court's Advisory Committee on Minority Concerns will sponsor two expungement seminars in the month of June. The seminars will be conducted by Ombudsman Nalo S. Brown. Acting Assistant Prosecutor Cheryl Cohen, Esq. will be the guest speaker.

The seminars will provide the community with information about who is eligible for expungement; which types of convictions can and cannot be expunged; how an expungement is filed; and what happens at the expungement hearing. The audience will have the opportunity to ask questions about the expungement process.

With the guidance of the New Jersey Supreme Court Committee on Minority Concerns, the Camden Vicinage Minority Concerns Committee works to assure fairness, impartiality, equal access, and full participation of ethnic and racial minorities in the Judiciary. These seminars are but one example of the programs and initiatives the Committee has offered in the effort to increase the community's understanding of and access to the judicial system.

The first seminar will take place on Monday, June 11, from 3 to 5 p.m. at the Camden County Store at Cherry Hill Mall, Suite 210, Upper Level, Cherry Hill. The second will be held on Monday, June 18, from 5 to 7 p.m. at the Camden County College Technology Center, Camden City Campus, 600 Cooper Street, Classroom 203.

The seminars are free of charge and are open to all Camden County residents.
