Middlesex Vicinage to Conduct Landlord/Tenant Workshop

New Brunswick, NJ – The Superior Court of New Jersey Middlesex Vicinage will present a workshop for landlords and tenants on Wednesday, March 12 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. in the Board of Chosen Freeholders meeting room on the first floor at 75 Bayard Street, New Brunswick.

Court staff participating in the presentation will include Civil Division Manager Joseph Lynch, Assistant Division Manager Cheryl Williams, and Vicinage Ombudsman Sylvia L. O'Connor. Also presenting will be attorney Renee Anthony and Martha Rodriguez, landlord, tenant and fair housing Counselor of the Puerto Rican Action Board.

The workshop will provide participants with information about the rights of landlords and tenants with regard to evictions, warrants of removal and illegal lockouts.
