Morris/Sussex Vicinage Announces Wireless Access

Morristown – The Superior Court of New Jersey, Morris/Sussex Vicinage, is pleased to announce that wireless internet access is now available throughout the Morris County Courthouse, at Washington and Court Streets, Morristown. Wireless access is also available on the 4th floor of the Morris County Administration and Records Building, on Court Street in Morristown.

Wireless access can maximize productivity for attorneys, litigants, jurors, witnesses and other court users. “This courthouse enhancement allows court users to stay in touch with the office, access online databases, check e-mail or explore the Internet while they wait for their court event,” said Assignment Judge B. Theodore Bozonelis.

To access the wireless network, court users need only double click on the wireless network icon on their laptop display and then click on the “New Jersey Judiciary Public Network” selection. The network allows broad access to the Internet, but some sites may be restricted due to content. The connection to the network is terminated when the user logs off or shuts down the laptop.
