Wireless Internet Access Now Available at Sussex County Judicial Center

Wireless Internet access is now available throughout the Sussex County Judicial Center, located at 43-47 High Street, Newton, New Jersey.

Sussex County court users are now able to send e-mail and access the Internet throughout the Judicial Center from their personal laptops, including the law library and the jury assembly room.

Assignment Judge B. Theodore Bozonelis said, "Wireless access has been a well-received enhancement to courthouses around the state and we are pleased to be able to offer this convenience to attorneys, litigants and other court visitors in Sussex County."

To access the wireless network, court users need only double click on the wireless network icon on their laptop display, click on the "New Jersey Judiciary Public Network" selection, and log on. The network allows broad access to the Internet, but some sites may be restricted due to content. The connection to the network is terminated when the user logs off or shuts down the laptop.
