Passaic Vicinage Superior Court Offers Childcare Program to Litigants

The Passaic Vicinage Superior Court has joined with Memorial Day Nursery School to help Superior Court litigants arrange care for their children while they are in court. The school, located at 397 Grant St., Paterson, will provide free care to children ages 2 ½ through 13 years.

“Some parents simply have no choice but to bring their children with them to court,” said Assignment Judge Donald J. Volkert Jr. “This partnership will allow parents the peace of mind to know that their children are being cared for so that they can concentrate on their case. The children will be able to enjoy age-appropriate activities instead of having to remain still and quiet while the grown-ups are in court.”

After signing in at the courthouse, parents will be asked to walk their child to the school, which is located between the courthouse at 77 Hamilton St. and the County Administration Building at 401 Grand Street. The school will provide activities, snacks and lunch. Parents must supply diapers, if needed. The school does not accept children who are ill or running a fever.

Founded in 1887, Memorial Day Nursery School is the oldest preschool in New Jersey. It is currently under the leadership of Director Rita Butts.
