Essex Vicinage to Hold Criminal and Juvenile Record Expungement Seminar

Newark—New Jersey Superior Court Essex Vicinage will hold an expungement seminar on Wednesday, Feb. 25. The seminar will take place at the East Orange Public Library, 21 S. Arlington Ave., 2nd floor, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.

A record of an arrest or conviction often is revealed when a person applies for a job, school or military service. The purpose of New Jersey's expungement law is to give a person who has either one or very few convictions a "fresh start." The law also provides for the removal of records of arrests where the arrest did not end in a conviction.

Representatives from the Essex County Prosecutor's Office, Essex-Newark Legal Services and judiciary staff will conduct the seminar.

Essex Vicinage has organized the seminar in an attempt to answer many of the questions that the public has about expungements. Some of the issues that will be addressed at the seminar include the process for criminal and juvenile expungements, the types of records that can be expunged, the time requirements for an expungement and what happens after an expungement is granted.

This is a free seminar and no registration is required.
