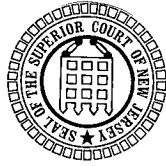

### **Hudson Vicinage to Hold Court Night**

Jersey City - The Superior Court of New Jersey, Hudson Vicinage, in partnership with the Hudson County Bar Association and the Advisory Committee on Minority Concerns is hosting Court Night in honor of Law Day 2009. The Law Day Activities Committee, chaired by Family Presiding Judge Maureen B. Mantineo, is coordinating the efforts of this legal workshop. Back by popular demand, the program is open to residents of Hudson County. It will be held on Wednesday, April 29, at the Justice William J. Brennan Courthouse, 583 Newark Ave., Jersey City, from 5:30 to 9:15 p.m.

Court Night is a community education program that will provide practical information to Hudson County residents on legal issues that are important to them. The program will be conducted in two sessions, from 5:30 to 7:15 p.m. and from 7:30 to 9:15 p.m. Both sessions will include information on immigration, landlord/tenant disputes, juvenile offender prevention, divorce, child support, and expungements of criminal records. Each of these interactive sessions will have a panel of presenters, including attorneys and court personnel, who will present the legal and practical aspects concerning the subject matter. A question and answer session will follow.
