Burlington Vicinage Minority Concerns Committee Presents Community Law Day Senior Information Fair

MOUNT HOLLY – The Burlington Vicinage Superior Court Advisory Committee on Minority Concerns will host a senior information fair on Thursday, May 7 from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. The event will take place at the Willingboro Township Senior Citizen Center, 429 John F. Kennedy Way, Willingboro.

The program will offer practical information to the senior community and highlight the programs and services available to assist them in Burlington County. Topics such as safety, legal rights and services, consumer fraud awareness, probate, wills, and veteran services will be addressed. Representatives from the following agencies will be on site to answer questions: Burlington County Military and Veterans Services, Office of Consumer Affairs, Sheriff's Department, Surrogate's Office, Office on Aging, New Jersey Office of the Public Guardian and the Willingboro Senior Center.

The event is free and open to the public; registration is not required.

The Vicinage Advisory Committee on Minority Concerns advises the assignment judge on developing local initiatives to improve the administration of justice for all residents of Burlington County and focuses on issues involving public education, availability of court services, minority inclusion, self-represented litigants, and juvenile justice. Goals for the committee include establishing better communication with the community and expanding job recruitment efforts for minorities in the courts.
