**Morris/Sussex Vicinage Holds Its First “Aging Out” Seminar**

The Superior Court of New Jersey, Morris/Sussex Vicinage, will host its first “Aging Out” workshop on Monday, May 11, from 2:30 to 4:30 p.m. at Daytop Village, 80 W. Main Street, Mendham. The workshop, a joint effort between the Rutgers University Child Advocacy Center (CAC) and the New Jersey Child Placement Advisory Council, is for young people, ages 15 to 20, who are involved in the child welfare system.

The workshop will acquaint young people in the system with their rights and with the services available to them as they transition out of supervision by the New Jersey Division of Youth and Family Services and into independence. The program will begin with an information fair, which will include representatives from various schools, employers and vocational programs, including the College of St. Elizabeth’s, New Jersey Building Trades Council and Lincoln Technical Institute. Designees from the Office of the Law Guardian and Court Appointed Special Advocates will be on hand to provide information and answer questions. At 3:30 p.m., Nana Wilson of the CAC will give the keynote address.
