Burlington Vicinage to Sponsor Free Landlord/Tenant Seminar

MOUNT HOLLY – The Superior Court of New Jersey, Burlington Vicinage Advisory Committee on Minority Concerns, will sponsor a free seminar about landlord and tenant law on May 19 from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. at the Burlington County Office Building, Courtroom 2, 49 Rancocas Road, Mount Holly.

The program will provide information to the public on the rights of landlords and tenants, the landlord/tenant legal process, including how a complaint is filed, what happens in court, and what happens after the court decision. The seminar will benefit both current and prospective tenants and landlords.

Crook, supervising judge of the special civil part; JoAnn Ezze, assistant civil division manager; Amy Chack, special civil part team leader; Denise Bostrom of the special civil part, and attorney Jules A. Maria A. Born, a lawyer with South Jersey Legal Services, will provide an overview of the legal representation services available for qualified applicants to address landlord/tenant matters.
