Morris/Sussex Vicinage to Conduct Expungement Seminar

Morristown, NJ – The Superior Court of New Jersey, Morris/Sussex Vicinage, will present an expungement seminar on June 22 from 6 to 8 p.m. at the Morris County Library, 30 E. Hanover Ave., Whippany.

Panelists for the session will be Criminal Presiding Judge Thomas V. Manahan; Judge Michael Paul Wright, chair of the Morris/Sussex Vicinage Advisory Committee on Minority Concerns; Catherine Broderick, assistant Morris County prosecutor and attorneys Vijayant Pawar and Ben A. Kaplan.

The seminar will provide participants with information about which court records are eligible for expungement, the laws and related court procedures related to expungement, and the benefits of having a criminal record expunged.
