Monmouth Vicinage Self-Help Resource Center Announces 2014 Workshop Series

The Monmouth Vicinage's Self-Help Resource Center has announced the course schedule for its 2014 workshop series.

The annual workshop series presents an opportunity for the public to learn about specific types of court cases, particularly those in which litigants most often choose to represent themselves in court. The seminars are conducted in conjunction with Ocean-Monmouth Legal Services and are held at the Monmouth County Courthouse, 71 Monument Park, Freehold.

The divorce, support, and custody seminar provides information on how to file for a divorce, which forms and documents must be submitted, and what happens at the court hearing. It also provides information on how to file an initial application for child support and custody, how to modify existing court orders, child support guidelines, alimony, and the emancipation of children.

The expungement seminar provides information on the types of records that can be expunged, how to file for an expungement, and what happens at the hearing.

Sessions are free and open to the public. They are informational only, so individual cases cannot be discussed or resolved. Space is limited and reservations are necessary. To reserve space, call 732-677-4595 or email Monreservations@judiciary.state.nj.us.
