Supreme Court Delays Implementation of Portions of New Guidelines for the Use of Electronic Devices in Court Proceedings

The Supreme Court has decided to delay the implementation of the requirement for all court users to present a signed agreement in order to use electronic equipment for purposes other than broadcasting, recording or photographing court proceeding. No new date is set for the requirement to be in effect.

All other aspects of the new Supreme Court Guidelines for Using Electronic Devices in Court Proceedings remain in place. The “Request for Permission to Photograph, Electronically Record or Broadcast a Court Proceeding” must be submitted by court users who plan to do so.

The Court made the determination in order to consider some concerns raised by the New Jersey Bar Association and others about the processing and other administrative details of the requirement.
