### **Camden Vicinage to Hold Law Day Celebration**

In celebration of the 56<sup>th</sup> annual Law Day, the Camden Vicinage will host high school students from Camden County Technical Schools in Pennsauken and Gloucester Township on Friday, May 1 from 9 a.m. to noon at the Camden County Hall of Justice in Camden.

Criminal Presiding Judge Edward J. McBride will provide opening remarks. U.S. Magistrate Judge Karen Williams of the U.S. District Court for the District of New Jersey will be the guest speaker.

Students will observe and participate in a panel discussion moderated by Family Court Judge Morris G. Smith. Panelists will include Administrative Law Judge Lisa James Beavers, Camden County Bar Foundation President Brenda Lee Eustler, and Assistant Deputy Public Defender Felicia Felder. Closing remarks will be delivered by Family Division Presiding Judge Charles W. Dortch Jr.

Students who competed in vicinage essay, poetry and poster competitions, which focused on the 2015 Law Day theme, “Magna Carta: Symbol of Freedom Under Law,” also will be recognized.
