Burlington Vicinage to Offer Free Expungement Seminar

A free workshop on how to expunge a criminal record will be held on Tuesday, Nov. 10 from 6 to 7 p.m. at the Burlington County Library, 5 Pioneer Blvd., Westampton.

Attorney Mark Natale and Burlington County Assistant Prosecutor Alexis Agre will be the guest speakers.

A criminal conviction can interfere with one's ability to obtain a job, security clearance, or possibly financial aid when pursuing education. An expungement is a legal remedy available for certain criminal and disorderly persons convictions that can help offenders clear their criminal records.

Topics will include the types of criminal and juvenile records that can be expunged, the time requirements to be eligible for an expungement, how to prepare and file an expungement application, and what happens after an expungement is granted. Forms will be available.

The seminar is sponsored by the Burlington Vicinage Advisory Committee on Minority Concerns. This is an informational session. No individual cases can be discussed or resolved. Registration is not required.
