Middlesex Vicinage to Host Expungement Seminar

The Middlesex Vicinage will hold an expungement seminar on Wednesday, Feb. 28 from 6 to 8 p.m. at the New Brunswick Public Library, 60 Livingston Ave., New Brunswick.

The seminar, sponsored by the vicinage's Advisory Committee on Minority Concerns, will provide participants with information on the types of criminal and juvenile records that can be expunged, the time requirements to be eligible for an expungement, how to prepare and file an expungement and what happens after an expungement is granted. Expungement form packets will be available.

Representatives from the Judiciary, the Middlesex County Bar Association and Legal Services of New Jersey will conduct the seminar.

A Spanish interpreter will be available.
