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Passaic Vicinage Presents Three Expungement Clinics

The Passaic Vicinage will hold a series of expungement seminars for those seeking to clear their criminal record.

The first clinic, on Thursday, March 8, will run from 6 to 7:30 p.m. at St. Luke Baptist Church, 136 Carroll St., Paterson. Paterson attorney William J. Marotta III will discuss the expungement process.

The second clinic is on Monday, March 19 from 2 to 4 p.m. and the third event is on Tuesday, March 27 from 5 to 7 p.m., both in Training Room 513 on the fifth floor of the Passaic County Administration Building, 401 Grand St., Paterson.

These two clinics will be geared toward those who graduated from the drug court program before April 18, 2016. Attorneys from Legal Services will discuss the expungement process and the new expungement laws. Following the presentation, staff from the vicinage will be available to assist attendees with the expungement application.

All three clinics will provide participants with information on the types of criminal and juvenile records that can be expunged, the time requirements to be eligible for an expungement, how to prepare and file an expungement and what happens after an expungement is granted.
