Middlesex Vicinage to Hold Law Day Celebration

The Middlesex Vicinage will hold its annual Law Day celebration on Wednesday, May 23 from 3 to 4 p.m. in courtroom 201, second floor of the Middlesex County Courthouse, 56 Paterson St., New Brunswick.

Students from West Windsor - Plainsboro High School North will be honored for winning this year's Middlesex County Mock Trial Competition. Judges from the vicinage will participate in the program.

Assignment Judge Alberto Rivas will speak about this year's Law Day theme, "Separation of Powers: Framework for Freedom." Superior Court judges will visit local schools to discuss the Law Day theme.

Recorded remarks by Chief Justice Stuart Rabner marking the occasion will be featured.
