## **Cumberland/Gloucester/Salem Vicinage to Host Landlord/Tenant Seminars**

The Cumberland/Gloucester/Salem Vicinage and South Jersey Legal Services will host two landlord/tenant seminars on Wednesday, March 6 to explain court processes and procedures.

The first seminar will be held from 10 a.m. to noon in courtroom A207 of the Cumberland County Courthouse, 60 W. Broad St., Bridgeton. The second will take place from 2 to 4 p.m. in the jury assembly room of the Salem County Courthouse, 92 Market St., Salem.

Topics will include how to file a complaint, service requirements, what to expect in court, grounds for eviction, the mediation process, habitability, leases, repairs and rents, warrants of removal and the Security Deposit Act. There also will be a question-and-answer session.

A representative from the Judiciary's Special Civil Part will answer procedural questions related to landlord/tenant cases.

The seminar is free and open to the public. This is an informational seminar. No individual cases will be discussed or resolved.
